#### The World

- Do not love the world or anything in the world (1 Jn 2:15)
- Don't you know that friendship with the world is hatred toward God? (Jam 4:4)
- No one can serve two masters. Either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other (Matt 6:24)
- Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth (Matt 6:19)

### Old Self

- *Old self*, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires (Eph 4:22)
- The *sinful nature* (Col 2:11)
- Dead in your sins (Col 2:13)
- Your *earthly nature*; the life you once lived (Col 3:5, 7)
- *Old self* with its practices (Col 3:9)
- Controlled by the *sinful nature* (Rom 7:5)
- The mind of *sinful man* is death; hostile to God; cannot please Him (Rom 8:6-8)
- The whole world is a *prisoner of sin* (Gal 3:22)
- *All have sinned* and fall short of the glory of God (Rom 3:23)
- The wages of *sin is death* (Rom 6:23)

# I have been crucified with Christ...

#### Crucified

- We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that... (Rom 6:4)
- Since *you died* with Christ to the basic principles of this world... (Col 2:20)
- We have been *united with him* like this *in his death...* (Rom 6:5)
- We have died with Christ... (Rom 6:8, 2 Tim 2:11)
- Your body *is dead* because of sin... (Rom 8:10)
- We always carry around *in our body* the *death* of Jesus... (2 Cor 4:10)
- ...becoming like him in his death (Phil 3:10)

## The life I live in the body...

#### Dead to Sin

- We *died* to sin; how can we live in it any longer? (Rom 6:2)
- Old self was *crucified* with him; no longer slaves to sin (Rom 6:6)
- Those who belong to Christ Jesus have *crucified* the sinful nature with its passions and desires. (Gal 5:24)
- The world has been *crucified* to me, and I to the world (Gal 6:14)
- For through the law I *died* to the law so that I might live for God (Gal 2:19)
- For you died (Col 3:3)

### So Die for Christ


- Dying to what once bound us, released from the law so that we serve in the Spirit (Rom 7:6)
- Put to *death* the misdeeds of the body (Rom 8:13)
- Put to *death*, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature (Col 3:5)

**I die daily** (1 Cor 15:31)

## I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

### Live by Faith

- The righteous will *live by faith* (Rom 1:17, Gal 3:11)
- Live by faith, not by sight (2 Cor 5:7)
- But my righteous one will live by faith. (Heb 10:38)
- Through *faith in him* we may approach God with freedom and confidence (Eph 3:12)
- Faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see (Heb 11:1)
- But hope that is seen is no hope at all. Who hopes for what he already has? (Rom 8:24)



## Made new in the attitude of your mind (Eph 4:23)

#### Do not...

- Do not offer the parts of your body to sin, as instruments of wickedness... (Rom 6:13)
- Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world... (Rom 12:2)
- Do not conform to the evil desires you had when you lived in ignorance...
- (1 Pet 1:14)
- Do not live your earthly life for evil human desires... (1 Pet 4:2)
- Do not to be arrogant nor put your hope in wealth...
   (1 Tim 6:17)

Count yourself *dead* to sin... (Rom 6:11)

Not as I will...

(Matt 26:39)

## ...but rather

- ...but rather offer yourselves to God, as instruments of righteousness (Rom 6:13)
- ...but be transformed by the renewing of your mind (Rom 12:2)
- ...but just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do (1 Pet 1:15)
- ...but rather for the will of God (1 Pet 4:2)
- ...but put your hope in God (1 Tim 6:17)

...but *alive* to God in Christ Jesus
(Rom 6:11)

...but as you will (Matt 26:39)

(1 Cor 13:12)

### **Alive In Christ**

- God made you *alive* in Christ (Col 2:13)
- We have passed from death to *life* (Jn 5:24, 1 Jn 3:14)
- He who has the Son has *life* (1 Jn 5:12)
- By believing you may have *life* in his name (Jn 20:31)
- Whoever believes has *eternal life* (John 3:15, 16, 36, 6:47)
- Your *life* is now hidden with Christ in God; who is your *life*. (Col 3:3-4)

## but Christ lives in me.

## So Live for Chirst

- Those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died and was raised again (2 Cor 5:15)
- We live to the Lord (Rom 14:8)
- Whatever you do, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus (Col 3:17)
- Whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God (1 Cor 10:31)
- Offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God (Rom 12:1)

To live is Christ (Phil 1:21)

## The Kingdom of God

- But *seek first* his kingdom and his righteousness (Matt 6:33)
- Let us *fix our eyes* on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith (Heb 12:2)
- Fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen (2 Cor 4:18)

## New Self

- If anyone is in Christ, he is a *new creation*, the old has gone, the new has come (2 Cor 5:17)
- *New self*, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness (Eph 4:24)
- In Him you have been made *complete* (Col 2:10)
- Have put on the *new self*, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator (Col 3:10)
- He has made *perfect* forever those who are being made holy (Heb 10:14)
- For we are *God's workmanship, created* in *Christ Jesus* to do good works (Eph 2:10)

#### Resurrected

- ...just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may *live a new life* (Rom 6:4)
- ...you have been raised with Christ (Col 3:1)
- ...we will certainly also be *united* with him *in his resurrection* (Rom 6:5)
- ...we will also *live with him* (Rom 6:8, 2 Tim 2:11)
- ...yet your *spirit is alive* because of righteousness (Rom 8:10)
- ...so that the *life of Jesus* may also be revealed in our body (2 Cor 4:10)
